**1. Call to order and Pledge of Allegiance**

**2. Roll Call and Determination of Quorum**

The roll was called and quorum determined.

**3. Discussion of Temporary Art Proposal From Emma Anna and The Bloomberg Grant**

The Committee discussed with Arts Commission Member Tom Gargiulo the “Imag\_ne” arts proposal as well as the Bloomberg Public Art Challenge Grant. Much of the discussion centered on funding and the deadline of December 15, 2014 to apply for the Bloomfield Grant. Also Mr. Butler discussed with the members the idea of making a permanent outdoor art display area similar to what other cities in the state of Florida have done. Mr. Butler asked “What would the artist need to bring art outdoors?” “Would they need a concrete pad? Mr. Gargiulo said “yes, something like that”.

Mr. Butler asked “How big a pad would they need?”

Mr. Gargiulo answered “Don’t know you would have to work with the artist”.

Discussion of a permanent pad art installation ensued and various artists who may be interested.

Mrs. Salkovitz asked, “How long would you keep the “Imag\_ne” art installation in Palm Coast?”

Then a discussion of moving the “Imag\_ne” art installation around the City of Palm Coast took place.

Mr. Partelow asked Mr. Butler, "What do you need from us tonight?"

Mr. Butler answered "I was hopeful to get more representation from the Art Commission tonight, but unfortunately we will not have that. We may need another special meeting to formulate a plan".

The Committee discussed the matter and after a long discussion two votes were taken. The motion on the first vote was:

1) Does the Committee agree to move forward with the "Imag\_ne" art installation proposal for a two-month display period at a cost of \$2950.00? Mr. Partelow made the motion to take a vote and it was Mr. Kapcar. The committee voted yes, by a 2-1 margin.

The second motion was:

2) Does the Committee recommend that the City of Palm Coast apply for the Bloomberg Grant with the "Imag\_ne" art installation proposal only? Mr. Partelow made a motion to take a vote and it was seconded by Mr. Kapcar. The Committee voted no, by a 2 -1 margin.

Mrs. Salkovitz made a Motion to Adjourn. Mr. Jones seconded the Motion.
