RULES OF CONDUCT FOR PUBLIC MEETINGS

- In accordance with the American Disabilities Act, persons needing assistance to participate in any of these proceedings should contact Kathy Maker, Human Resources, at 386/986-3720 at least 48 hours prior to the meeting or visit Palm Coast City Hall, 160 Cypress Point Parkway, Suite B106.
- All speakers – whether they are BEAC members, City Staff, the Applicant, or the Public – must first be recognized by the BEAC Chair unless the Chair states that the floor is open for direct interaction.
- Prior to speaking, members of the public shall state their name and address for the public record.
- Public comments on agenda items and other issues shall be limited to 2 minutes. Individuals are not permitted to speak multiple times on the same agenda item or issue unless authorized by the Chair.
- All public comments shall be directed through the podium. All parties shall be respectful of other persons' ideas and opinions. Clapping, cheering, jeering, booing, catcalls, and other forms of disruptive behavior from the audience are not permitted.
- All pagers and cell phones shall remain OFF while the BEAC is in session.
