Director Santangelo suggested that the next step might be presenting this concept to the Parks Team to acquire more information and detail. After further discussion by the Committee, Committee Member Dawson-Andrzejczyk made a motion to move forward with this by having Director Santangelo take this concept to the Parks Team Meeting. Chairman Hurlie seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.*
